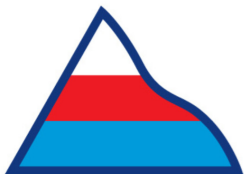

Monthly crime figures for May 2026 (difference with April figures):

Violent crime against person: 4 (-1), theft: 1 (same as April), criminal damage: 1 (+1), burglary 0 (same as April), public order: 2 (same as April), vehicle crime: 0 (same as April), other: 2 (+2)

Community updates:

ASB Awareness Week – 29th June to 5th July 2026 is a national UK campaign led by Resolve and supported by police, councils, housing providers, and community groups. Its aim is to:

- Raise awareness of anti-social behaviour (ASB) and its impact,
- Encourage people to report incidents and seek support,
- Highlight the work of police and partner agencies
- Promote safer communities and joint problem-solving ASB includes issues like nuisance, noise, harassment, vandalism, off-road bikes, and disorderly behaviour – things that cause alarm, distress, or nuisance to others.

Shop theft updates:

Over the last few months, we have seen a decrease in the overall number of shop thefts reported at our local stores, and importantly, an increase in number of offenders identified and action taken.

SNT priorities:

Over the last month, *Dronfield Safer Neighbourhood Team* have been engaging with the community and visitors to the area in relation to SNT policing priorities.

The results below have come about from speaking with the community on patrols, public events, attending public meetings such as Parish or Town Council meetings. 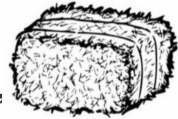

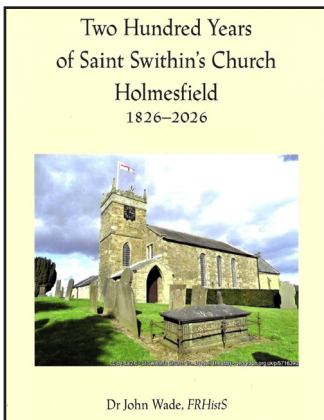


HOLMESFIELD CELEBRATES THE BI-CENTENARY OF ITS PARISH CHURCH

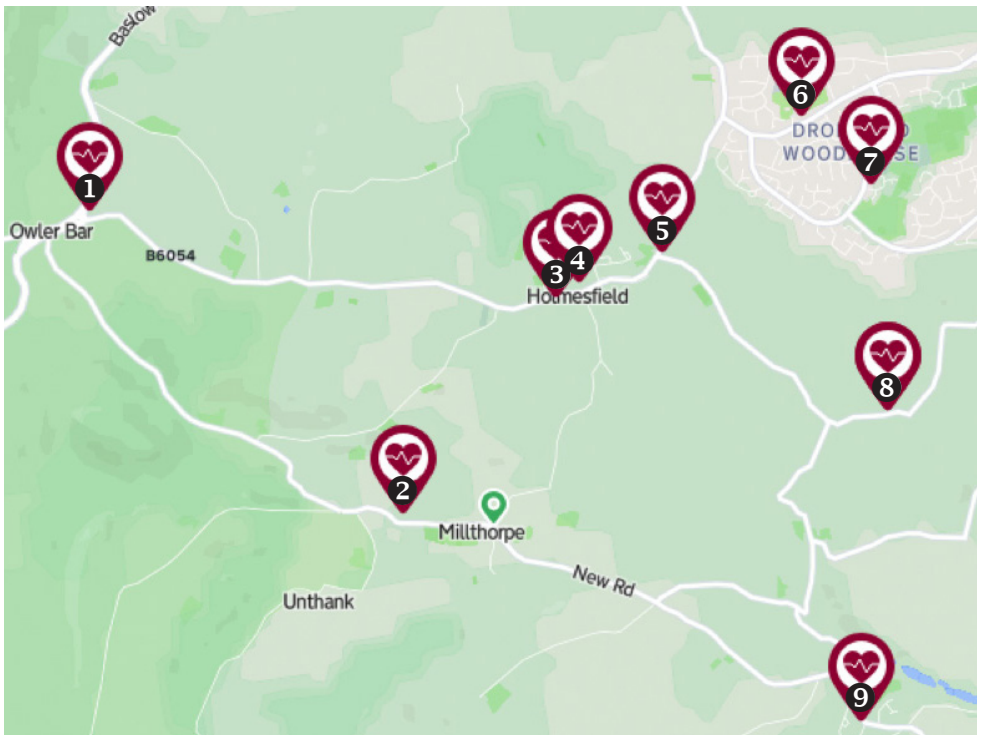

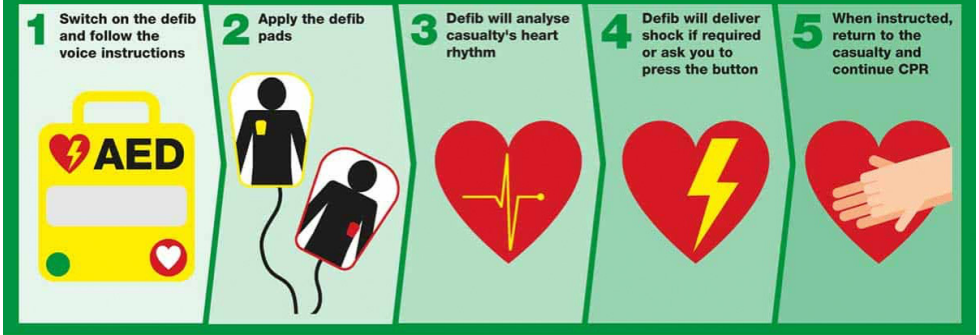

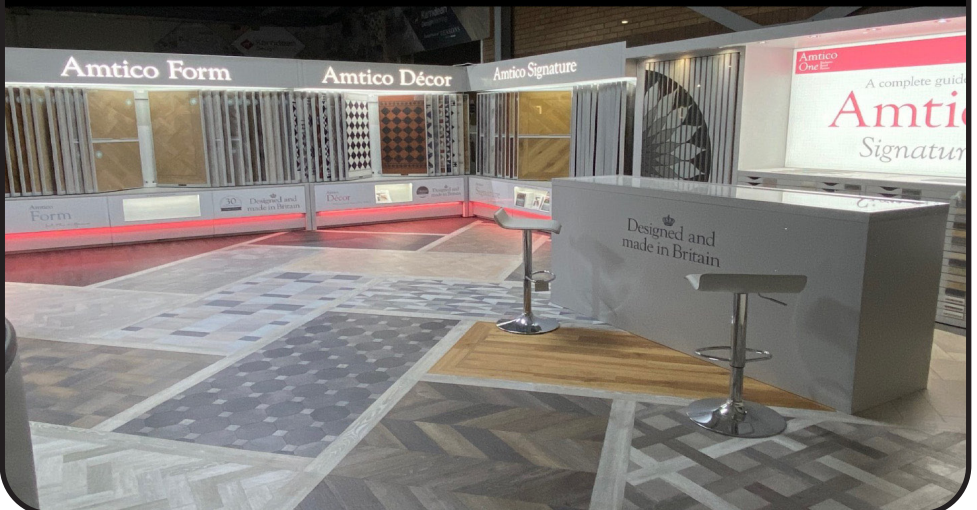

APRIL-MAY 2026 WEATHER

As I write this note on 10th June, the outside temperature is only 11°C and last night, it dropped to 6°C. However, the forecast for the coming weekend is for hot weather, well above 20°C.

The last six weeks have been characterised by these large swings in our weather. The month of May was most peculiar in that the average temperature over the second half of the month was ten degrees warmer than the first half of the month. The highest temperature I recorded during May was 30.6°C and the lowest 1.9°C. Overall, the month was about one degree warmer than normal. We were able to enjoy 332 hours of bright sunshine, much of which occurred during the second half of the month.

Rainfall during May was 59mm, which is slightly below what normally falls. The gardens needed this rain as the previous two months had been very dry.

I have just checked the Met Office's long range forecast. It says that June should be warmer than normal with dry sunny weather after a few unsettled days. July should be settled and dry initially. This information is rather vague in my opinion. However, the met Office does say that their forecasts are fairly accurate for up to five days, but after that they become increasingly uncertain. The Met Office is based in Exeter and uses huge computers to solve the differential equations that describe how the atmosphere changes from a given starting point.

It is interesting that the first person to set about forecasting the weather by solving mathematical equations was Lewis Fry Richardson. He was a mathematician, physicist and meteorologist who lived from 1881 until 1953. Born in Newcastle as the youngest of seven children, he was bright and got a first class degree in Physics from King's College, Cambridge. However, he was a Quaker and a conscientious objector in the first world war, and whilst that exempted him from military service, as a consequence he was disqualified from having any further University posts. He worked for the Meteorological Office at Eskdalemuir Observatory in Scotland until 1916 and then volunteered for the 'Friends' Ambulance Unit' in France until 1919.

In 1922 he published a paper called 'Weather Prediction by Numerical Process'. He even tried it out using slide rule calculations and showed that he could make a forecast for the next six hours. However, it was 1950 before the Met Office actually started using computer generated forecasts. Richardson was still alive and said that this was 'an enormous scientific advance'.

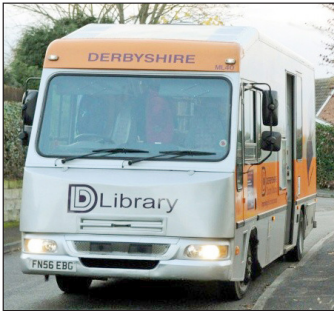

What can I put in my Food Waste Caddy?

Yes please:

Raw and cooked food
Meat, fish, shellfish (including meat/fish bones)
Fruit, salad, vegetables, vegetable peelings
Eggs including egg shells
Dairy products (No Milk)
Bread, cakes and other baked goods
Pasta, rice, beans and pulses
Tea bags and coffee grounds
Lard and other hard fats
Any meal leftovers and plate scrapings
Pet food
Mouldy and out of date food

Food can be placed in compostable food bags manufactured to the British Standard EN 13432 only. (No retail carrier bags). The use of liners is optional, however, we recommend compostable liners to help keep the caddy clean.

What can't I put in my Food Waste Caddy?

No thanks:

Liquids
Oils and soft fats
Packaging (unless specified as compostable)
Bags (except compostable bags manufactured to the British Standard EN 13432)
Coffee filters and pods (even those that are compostable)
Non-food items (including dead animals which do not qualify as food waste).

Please do not contaminate your food waste container with unsuitable waste. If incorrect items are found in your food waste caddy, it may unfortunately not be emptied. In such cases, you will need to remove the contamination, and the caddy will be collected on your next scheduled collection day.

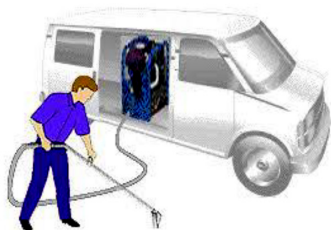

COURIER FRAUD: OVER 70S TARGETED

Courier fraud occurs when criminals contact you by phone and convince you to hand over money or your debit/credit card under false pretences with the average amount stolen per victim now standing at £15,311.08, underlining the significant financial harm caused by each offence.

Detective Superintendent Ollie Little, from the City of London Police, said: “Courier fraud is a cruel and calculated crime that targets trust, often focusing on older and or vulnerable people. Offenders are becoming more organised and persistent, sometimes maintaining contact with victims for days or weeks to maximise what they can steal. Criminals are also evolving their tactics, increasingly using messaging platforms such as WhatsApp and courier services to facilitate collections. These changes are making fraud harder to detect and emphasise the need for greater public awareness, particularly among those most at risk and their families.

A key feature of this threat is the disproportionate targeting of older people, particularly those aged 70 and above. This group makes up majority of victims, with those aged between 76 and 96 alone accounting for around 62 per cent of all reports. Fraudsters often deliberately focus on older victims, exploiting trust in institutions such as the police and banks, as well as using pressure tactics, fear and urgency to manipulate them into complying with instructions.

How to spot the signs of courier fraud:

Courier fraud typically begins with an unexpected phone call from someone claiming to be a police officer or bank employee. Victims are told their account is at risk or that they are assisting with an investigation, before being instructed to withdraw money, purchase items, or disclose sensitive information. A courier is then sent to collect the items such as jewellery, cash, bank cards and PINs. In reality, this is the work of criminals and anything handed over is lost.

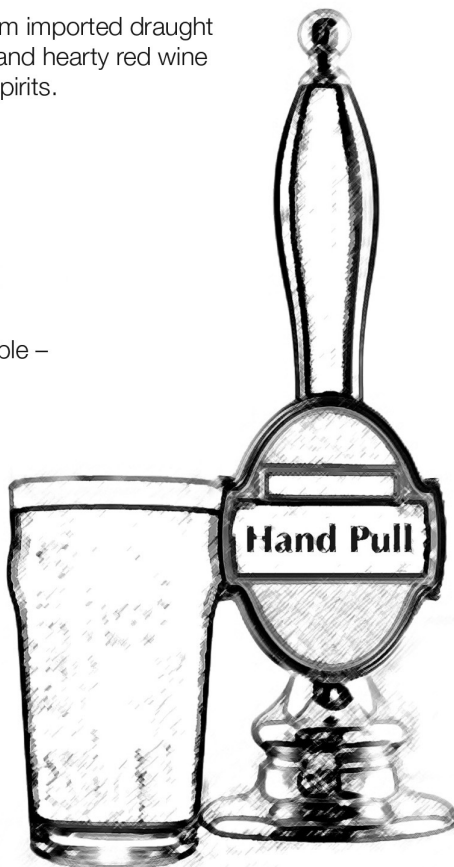
