

The road outside Holmesfield Penny Acres school is a reminder of how important it is to be aware of your speed, as the school is situated on a 30mph road which changes to the national speed limit close by.

The team spent a couple of hours on Friday 6th October with the infants, juniors and some of the teachers at the school checking the speeds of the cars that went past.



When cars were found to be exceeding the limit the children held up red paddles with a thumbs down picture. The children were also given the opportunity to hand over their handmade speed awareness letters to the drivers of the vehicles that had been pulled over, whilst putting on their best sad faces.



When drivers were found to be going the correct speed, the children held up green paddles with a thumbs up picture and celebrated by cheering as the cars drove past.

The children loved this activity (nearly as much as the staff) and they have shown a keen interest in encouraging adults to do the right thing – especially the ones dropping them off and collecting them from school.

Our rural project continues and we are keen to access any rural community groups within the area.

### HOLMESFIELD LOCAL MARKET UPDATE





- Improve the quality of life for local communities




