


HOLMESFIELD ARCHIVES



UNDERSTANDING ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR (ASB)

We hear the term ASB often, but do you know what is classed as anti-social behaviour? Often reports may not be necessary or they're reported to the wrong agency. Find out the correct reporting method and how we can support you on Derbyshire's ASB Hub: www.saferderbyshire.gov.uk/asbhub



Understanding anti-social behaviour (ASB)

We hear the term used often, but do you know what classes as anti-social behaviour?

The law defines anti-social behaviour as behaviour that 'causes, or is likely to cause, harassment, alarm or distress to any person'.

What anti-social behaviour is:

Anti-social behaviour covers many types of behaviour, such as:

- Noise nuisance
- Criminal damage, vandalism, graffiti
- Intimidation, threats, harassment
- Litter, dog fouling, fly tipping
- Deliberate fire setting
- Nuisance vehicles
- Drunken and rowdy behaviour in a public place or drug misuse
- Hate behaviour, targeting people because of their perceived differences.

What we take into consideration: How often the behaviour is happening, how serious it is and how it affects the people living in the community.

What anti-social behaviour is not:

A lot of reports to us are not necessarily acts of ASB, such as:

- The sound of children playing or a baby crying
- Everyday living noises, such as toilet flushing, closing doors, vacuuming
- Minor personal disputes and differences
- Young people gathering socially, unless they are being intimidating
- Someone being parked outside of your home, where there are no lawful restrictions in place
- DIY and car repairs unless they are taking place at unsocial hours
- Civil disputes between neighbours (e.g. shared driveways)
- Religious or cultural practice.





What can I put in my Food Waste Caddy?

Yes please:

Raw and cooked food
Meat, fish, shellfish (including meat/fish bones)
Fruit, salad, vegetables, vegetable peelings
Eggs including egg shells
Dairy products (No Milk)
Bread, cakes and other baked goods
Pasta, rice, beans and pulses
Tea bags and coffee grounds
Lard and other hard fats
Any meal leftovers and plate scrapings
Pet food
Mouldy and out of date food

Food can be placed in compostable food bags manufactured to the British Standard EN 13432 only. (No retail carrier bags). The use of liners is optional, however, we recommend compostable liners to help keep the caddy clean.

What can't I put in my Food Waste Caddy?

No thanks:

Liquids
Oils and soft fats
Packaging (unless specified as compostable)
Bags (except compostable bags manufactured to the British Standard EN 13432)
Coffee filters and pods (even those that are compostable)
Non-food items (including dead animals which do not qualify as food waste).

Please do not contaminate your food waste container with unsuitable waste. If incorrect items are found in your food waste caddy, it may unfortunately not be emptied. In such cases, you will need to remove the contamination, and the caddy will be collected on your next scheduled collection day.

REPORTING HGVs FLOUTING WEIGHT LIMITS

The Parish Council understands that there are two ways to report HGVs flouting weight limits in the parish.

The first is via *Trading Standards* at Derbyshire County Council. They have an online weight restriction monitoring form if you'd like to report any vehicles you believe are illegally using restricted roads. You'll need to provide details such as date and time of incident, registration number and location. If you have a photograph of the vehicle, it can be attached to the form.


They will collate the information and share it with Derbyshire police to inform and prioritise police-led enforcement action. Unlike the police, they have very limited powers to deal with vehicles that breach weight restrictions and will not be able to respond to individual reports. However, the information is important to help identify problem areas.

Alternatively, you can report incidents directly to the police, telephone: 101 and pass on the details or by following the link

FEBRUARY 2026 WEATHER

I am starting to write this report in the middle of February, because we are going to go away at the end of the month.

We had already had more than the normal rainfall for February. By 15th February, 83mm had already fallen and the eventual total for the month was 127mm. Interestingly, there were only two dry days (the 24th and 25th) in the whole month. So both January and February were extremely wet and you may well have seen the field beside the road, below The Rutland, looking like a lake.

The mean temperature for February was 4.5°C, which is about half a degree higher than my long term mean for February. The highest temperature was 12.6°C on the 24th and the lowest was -2.3°C on the 14th. I was a little surprised that the month was warmer than normal as the first half of the month had seemed to be very cold and we had some wet snow falling on a few days.

Snow can of course sometimes fall well into March. In 1947 snow fell on 22nd January, and from then until 17th March, snow fell every day somewhere in the UK. There were several falls of more than 60cm and at times there were drifts 15m deep covering roads and railways.

March weather can be unpredictable. The record high temperature in the UK for March was in 1968 on the 29th when the temp reached 25.6°C in Cambridgeshire. However, snow fell only a few days later.

I am unable to tell you about the weather over the first half of March as I am writing this report whilst at sea, a long way away from Holmesfield. I will have to wait for my friend in Bradway to let me know what happens in the rest of the month.

NEW LAWS FOR DOG OWNERS

Updated laws on livestock worrying come into force in England and Wales from Wednesday 18th March. Under the new rules, it is an offence if a dog chases, attacks, or causes distress to livestock. Importantly, the dog does not have to bite or injure the animal for it to count as livestock worrying.

Livestock includes animals such as:

- **Sheep**
- **Cattle**
- **Goats**
- **Pigs**
- **Horses**
- **Poultry**

Police will also have stronger powers to investigate incidents, including the ability to seize dogs involved in attacks.

Penalties can include unlimited fines and compensation for farmers if livestock are harmed.

Rural Derbyshire has so many public footpaths that pass through farmland, dog owners should ensure dogs are kept under close control and put on a lead where livestock are present.

This is simply to make people aware of the legal responsibilities when walking dogs near farm animals.









Following publication of last month's photograph of Cordwell Café and Cordwell Valley Stores, run by Dorothy and Edith Chettleburgh respectively, Mrs Pat Morton commented there was usually enough provisions available at the shop to avoid a weekly shopping trip to Chesterfield. There was also a third sister called Kathleen who lived down the road.

William Biggin added that the gentleman seen in last month's photograph was a local house builder named Tom Haslam who resided in the upstairs former chapel and was engaged to Edith, but they never married because she suffered what turned out to be a fatal heart attack. The shop and café had closed by 1964 and was bought by Mr Simpson, editor of the Sheffield Telegraph.
