NEW BIN CADDIES DELIVERED TO YOUR HOMES

Following the national introduction of Simpler Recycling, North East Derbyshire District Council are to commence the rollout of new food waste kerbside caddies.

When will the caddies be delivered to homes?

If your bin day is emptied on a Thursday – from 23rd February.

If your bin day is emptied on a Friday – from 2nd March.

What you will receive:

Each household will receive a brown 23-litre kerbside food waste caddy, containing usage instructions and a roll of food waste bags. These items will be placed on the curtilage of your property, typically near your front or side door.

Please store the caddy until the new food waste collections begin in Holmesfield from Thursday 7th / Friday 8th March.

For those households living in blocks of flats / apartments, there will be different systems of collections organised. These will be communicated directly to yourself prior to the 30th March start date.

DRONFIELD POLICE SAFER NEIGHBOURHOOD TEAM

Shop Theft Updates.:

Dronfield SNT is working closely with local shops to help reduce incidents of shop theft and keep our area welcoming for everyone. We're supporting stores with practical steps to deter unwanted behaviour, while also teaming up with partner agencies such as South Yorkshire Police to take appropriate action when needed. Recently, this joint approach has resulted in several community orders granted alongside other legal outcomes in court.



Community Speedwatch Schemes; WE NEED YOU

Community Speed Watch is a local Police initiative that gives trained volunteers the opportunity to play an active role in keeping our roads safer. Speeding is a concern for many residents—not only because of the risk of serious injury or death, but also due to the noise and pollution it brings to our neighbourhoods.

By working together, the police and the community can help identify and address speeding hotspots. This partnership approach allows us to speak directly with drivers, encourage safer behaviour, and make a real difference to the quality of life for everyone who lives, works, or travels in the area.







REPORTING HGVs FLOUTING WEIGHT LIMITS

The Parish Council understands that there are two ways to report HGVs flouting weight limits in the parish.

The first is via *Trading Standards* at Derbyshire County Council. They have an online weight restriction monitoring form if you'd like to report any vehicles you believe are illegally using restricted roads. You'll need to provide details such as date and time of incident, registration number and location. If you have a photograph of the vehicle, it can be attached to the form.


They will collate the information and share it with Derbyshire police to inform and prioritise police-led enforcement action. Unlike the police, they have very limited powers to deal with vehicles that breach weight restrictions and will not be able to respond to individual reports. However, the information is important to help identify problem areas.

Alternatively, you can report incidents directly to the police, telephone: 101 and pass on the details or by following the link

DECEMBER 2025 – JANUARY 2026 WEATHER

Last month, I speculated on the probability of us experiencing a white Christmas where I suggested a 20-25% chance. Well, as you will know we did not have a white Christmas in Holmesfield. However, we made up for this in early January as we had snowfall of about six inches on the 8/9th of the month, and as I write this on January 12th, it has just disappeared.

The snowfall was associated with storm Goretti that caused high winds and rain to the south of us, resulting in considerable damage in the SW of the country. The storm was named by Meteo France because they predicted that it would be a hazard for the north of France.

January has so far been very cold with a minimum of -5.2°C on the 5th and an average temperature of -0.1°C – well below our normal mean temperature for January of 4.0C. So far, Flanders and Swann in their '*A song of the weather*' were correct in singing, '*January brings the snow, Makes your feet and fingers glow!*'

Turning to December 2025, the average temperature was 5.4°C, which is almost one degree warmer than normal. My recorded temperature reached 12.5°C on 9th December.

The results for the whole year were an average temperature of 9.7°C and a total rainfall of 842mm. My average temperature is warmer than for a normal year, but not the warmest that I have recorded. We have had five warmer years since 2003.

December was also drier than normal, but again it was not the driest that I have recorded as we have experienced eight drier years since 2003. However, 2025 was our driest of the last ten years.

Watching the recent snowfall reminded me that what I thought snowflakes looked like was changed by a recent U3A (University of the third age) lecture that I enjoyed. I had thought that their six-pointed star shape was three dimensional and that they would look similar when viewed either from the front or the side. They are actually two-dimensional thin sheets, rather like flat leaves spread out on a flat surface to form a hexagonal pattern.

Travel Derbyshire on Demand is a new type of bus service. It must be booked in advance but is more flexible than a conventional bus. There is no fixed timetable, so pick up times, routes and destinations can be planned to suit the needs of where and when passengers want to travel. It is fully accessible and able to carry passengers in wheelchairs and has space for pushchairs. **Travel Derbyshire on Demand** is for everyone, young or old, and can be used for any type of journey. So if you want to visit friends, need to get to a medical appointment, the shops or work, then **Travel Derbyshire on Demand** is for you.

What journeys can I make on the service?

You can travel anywhere within the operating area, which covers the Districts of Bolsover and North East Derbyshire and the Borough of Chesterfield. You can also travel from within the operating area to and from Kings Mill Hospital in Sutton in Ashfield, or Alfreton train station.

How do I sign up?

Call **0115 969 1801** or use the **Travel Derbyshire on Demand** app, which can be downloaded via your usual app store. Register with your name, mobile phone number and email address.

When you first sign in, you will be asked for more information to enable your journey to be scheduled and to monitor use of the service.

How do I book a journey?

Call **0115 969 1801** or use the **Travel Derbyshire on Demand** app. Specify your preferred pick up or drop off time and we will try to meet your request or offer another time. If you have an appointment to meet, book your preferred drop off time. Allow plenty of time before your appointment to make sure you don't arrive late. Note that you may be on the bus for up to 75 minutes.

When does the service operate?

- Monday to Friday 7am to 7pm
- Saturdays 8am to 5pm
- No service on Sundays or Public Holidays, excluding Good Friday





We are grateful to Tom and Rachel Pearson for sharing this lovely photograph of the local children and staff at Penny Acres school around 100 years ago, though sadly there is no precise date.
