PCSO Jonathan Flower attended the meeting, he reported that there were links with the Youth Club run at the Church and that this was very positive. Also pleased to report that the Neighbourhood Watch is also very pro-active. There has been a burglary reported in April and one in May. There is currently a trend for smaller cars being stolen and used for low level crime and then being dumped. With regards to the parking issues at the top of Cowley Lane, Derbyshire County Council are looking at putting yellow lines around the area, and parking enforcement will look to issue tickets to offending vehicles.

Derbyshire County Council are in the process of moving the bench outside Penny Acres School and once this is done, speed checks will commence at that location.

There is some funding for Smart Water, this is a unique liquid that can be used on property and if property is stolen and then recovered can easily be returned to the correct owner. This will be advertised over social media.

- (b) Road Safety Derbyshire County Council are in the process of moving the bench outside Penny Acres School and once this is done, speed checks will commence at that location. The application for the Speed Indicator Device is in hand.

- (f) Playground The painting of equipment is being organised.
- (g) Football Pitch The bin is not emptied on a regular basis and the rubbish on the field is unsightly.
- (h) Peak Park The article has been put in the newsletter to update residents on the current situation with regards to the caravan/s at Owler Bar. The matter is with the legal team at the Peak District National Park Authority and an update will be issued as soon as this is available.
- (i) Neighbourhood Watch / Estate Walkabouts A meeting of the Neighbourhood Watch was held, PSCO Jonathan Flowers was in attendance, which was very useful. There was an interesting discussion on smart water, and how it can be used to return stolen goods to householders and also on the availability of household security assessments.
- (j) Environment There has been a number of incidents of flytipping in the Parish, with a particular bad spate off Horsleygate Road, the District Council have cleaned up the area adjacent to the road, but are not authorised to clear private land. It is not known who the landowner is in this location.

The latest bird surveys suggest a decline in numbers.

The Fire Service are able to undertake smoke alarm checks and give householder general safety advice.

(k) Village Hall – There has been a complaint from a resident that he is being blinded in his sitting room by the Village Hall car park lights. This was passed by the Caretaker to the Chairman. It has been investigated and concluded they are positioned in the opposite direction from his house, it is not possible that they shine into his house and therefore the complaint is dismissed. The carpark lights are important for the safety of users of the hall getting from the hall to the car park and will not be removed.

The meeting was held with the heating engineers to assess the works required for the replacement of the heating pipes under the hall floor.
