

POLICE REPORT TO PARISH COUNCIL

PCSO Jonathan Flower sent a written report to the Parish Council: During May 2023 there were four reported crimes, these included 1 theft, 1 burglary, 1 public order, and 1 of violence against the person.

PCSO Jonathan Flower also raised a few animal related concerns; one of which resulted in a person sustaining a minor injury by pet dog whilst on a walk. A poster has been supplied – *Are you in full control of your dog?* Please consider putting your dog on a lead. Police Advice – Under the law, any dog (of any breed or type) can be considered dangerous in any place if it is not kept under control. The dog doesn't have to bite anyone, it could just show aggressive behaviour that makes someone feel in fear for their safety.

There have been a couple of burglaries reported and residents are asked to be extra vigilant during the hot weather when leaving doors and windows open.

An investigation is ongoing following an incident in Millthorpe with a speeding vehicle.

HOLMESFIELD CHURCHYARD UPDATE

St. Swithin's Churchyard is a beautiful and sacred place at the heart of our community. Many of you will have passed through it over the years, even if it is just to walk the dog! Some of you will have family members or friends buried in the churchyard.

The church council (or DCC) is responsible for our churchyard, together with the Holmesfield Chapel Lands Trust, a small and ancient charity which supports the church. The DCC must manage the churchyard



according to regulations set down by the Diocese of Derby ensuring that monuments and other items (including those left in memory of loved ones) are in keeping with the historic and sacred setting. Generally speaking, trinkets, ornaments, vases, statuettes, flowerpots and artificial flowers are not permitted within the churchyard and may be removed at any time.

The cost of maintaining our churchyards to the same standard as municipal cemeteries is prohibitive, so we do the best we can, which is to undertake regular maintenance to keep it as safe as possible and to ensure the main pathways are clear. The church arranges for contractors to mow and strim around existing graves on a regular basis and this is part-funded by Holmesfield Parish Council. At certain times and places the grass may be left uncut to encourage and support wildlife.

Anyone who is or was a resident in the ecclesiastical parish of Dronfield with Holmesfield, plus those with other connections, may be buried in the churchyard. We no longer reserve specific grave plots but will honour arrangements already made. There is still space for new graves but now, sadly, a very limited number of spaces for new interments of ashes.

Memorials remain the property of the person who paid to have it erected or their immediate family. Their upkeep is the responsibility of the owner.





Derbyshire Constabulary is warning residents to be on their guard against 2-in-1 burglaries. This is where thieves break into a house, take the car keys, then steal the homeowner's car. Police have seen an increase in this type of crime in recent months. Don't tempt thieves! Many thieves are opportunists, don't make life easy for them. The more obstacles in their way the less likely they are to strike.

Don't leave your car keys on view on kitchen tables or hooks on walls or placed near windows or cat flaps where thieves can see and possibly reach them • Don't leave handbags, wallets or other valuables on display • Ensure you lock all doors and windows, even when you are at home • If no-one is home during the evening, leave a light on or a radio playing. Consider using a timing device • Don't leave tools, ladders or other implements outside, thieves could use these to gain entry to your property • Fit outside security lighting and an alarm if possible and ensure they are in working order. Always set them when you are out or go to bed. Remember to lock all gates, sheds and garage doors • Always lock your car and use devices such as steering wheel locks to make it less attractive to thieves. Fit an alarm or tracking device if you can afford to • If you have a garage, use it. If thieves can't see your car, they can't steal it. If you don't have a garage consider fitting gates or a security post to your driveway Protect your property • Keep it safe • Keep it locked

MAY 2023 WEATHER

May this year was not a disappointment. The average temperature was 11.7°C which is just over half a degree warmer than usual. The highest temperature was 22.9°C on the 27th and the lowest was 3.3°C on the third.

The first ten days of May were overcast with several days of rain but the rest of the month was very dry with some lovely sunshine. This spell of pleasant weather, which has continued into June, was the result of a large area of high pressure that was centred a little to the west of Ireland. The high pressure kept the Atlantic depressions away from us and so gave us pleasant dry and gentle weather. In this case the high pressure also gave us a lot of sunshine – I recorded 263 hours of bright sunshine – but there was a rather cool wind from the north east for many of the days. This wind also brought in some cloud from the North Sea on a few days so the month was not perfect. Nonetheless, Weston Park weather station did report that there were only three days without any sun during May.

I did not record any rain on 21 days and my total rainfall for the month was 27.4mm which is only 40% of the normal for May. Perhaps we were due for a dry month after the heavy rainfall we experienced in March and April.

Areas of high atmospheric pressure – anticyclones – are usually associated with calm weather. The first person to have measured atmospheric pressure and noted that the pressure varied with the weather was Evanglista Torricelli who worked with Galileo in Florence in the 1640s. He invented the mercury barometer and noted that the mercury level rose when the weather was sunny. Anticyclones are the opposite of low pressure weather systems. We often call times of low atmospheric pressure depressions and they can result in fairly depressing weather. The proper name for a depression is a cyclone. This term was first used by an English sea captain called Henry Piddington in the 1840s. He spent many years in Calcutta and noted that cyclones, or tropical storms, gave rise to strong winds that circulated in an anti-clockwise direction. He used the word cyclone because he saw the weather pattern as looking rather like a coiled snake.

A few years later in the 1860s a man called Francis Galton first used the word anticyclone for a high pressure region where the winds circulated in a clockwise direction in the northern hemisphere. He produced the first weather map that was published in The Times in 1875. Galton shared a grandfather with Charles Darwin and he was a very bright polymath. However, he would probably not be very popular today as he wrote and spoke a lot about eugenics – trying to improve the general intelligence of a population by excluding from breeding people judged to be inferior.

Are you in full control of your dog?





Some dogs can become aggressive and bite other people or animals. Any dog can become dangerous in the wrong hands!

Police Advice: Under the law any dog (of any breed or type) can be considered dangerous in any place if it is not kept under control. The dog doesn't have to bite anyone, it could just show aggressive behaviour that makes someone feel in fear for their safety.

Your dog is considered dangerously out of control if it: injures someone • makes someone worried that it might injure them.

Acourt could also decide that your dog is dangerously out of control if: It injures someone's animal • The owner of the animal thinks they could be injured if they tried to stop your dog attacking their animal

• In these cases, the police may prosecute and the penalties can be very severe with up to 14 years in prison if a dog kills someone.

It is very important to ensure your dog is properly socialised with people and animals from a young age as well as trained and cared for, to keep it safe.

For more information you can read section three of the Dangerous Dogs Act 1991 relating to Dogs Dangerously Out Of Control.




