SECURE YOUR GARDEN, PROTECT YOUR PET

Recent incidents have highlighted a need for dog owners to make sure their gardens are secure.

So far this year, we have seen multiple occasions where dogs have escaped gardens and gone on to chase and injure nearby sheep.

Sergeant Chris Wilkinson from our Rural Crime Team said: "In some of these incidents, the dogs haven't come back home, and significant harm has been caused to livestock.

Use the lighter evenings and better weather as a chance to check your fences and hedges and make sure your garden is secure. Even if you don't know your dog has escaped, you are still responsible for any harm it might do.

Remember: protect your dog, protect livestock. Whether that's at home, or whilst you're out walking your dog under close control."

SUPERVISING CHILDREN'S ONLINE ACTIVITY

Parents/Guardians should be aware about allowing your child unsupervised access to the internet and unlimited access to your bank details when playing games online. Monitor what kind of sites your child is visiting, keep track of who they are speaking to online, make sure you have security settings up to date and that your bank details can't be accessed without your permission.







GO FUND ME - 3RD HOLMESFIELD SCOUT GROUP

For the last 15 years, 3rd Holmesfield Scout Group have been meeting weekly in less than ideal meeting places, including barns, portakabins and outdoor shelters. We have explored various options including designing and building a brand new facility in Holmesfield but rising costs and fewer fund-raising opportunities have led us to



try to secure a permanent home in Dronfield at the current headquarters on Wreakes Lane. Our original plan was to develop what was the existing building but a few years ago it was deemed unsafe and sadly had to be demolished. Our small band of volunteers and 110 young people have, since then, been meeting in second hand portakabins which are damp, cold and very restrictive in terms of activity space.

Despite all the setbacks our membership has remained strong, we have remained at capacity for Beavers, Cubs, Scouts and Explorer Scouts with a group membership of over 100 young people, and now have a firm plan in place to develop Wreakes Lane Scout HO on behalf of the whole district.

So far we have raised almost £120,000 pounds with £50k coming from grants and £70k from our own fund-raising and careful budgeting over 20+ years.

The plan is to buy and install a 4 module building to create a large enough room for meetings and activities for both our group and others in and around Dronfield.

Planning permission has been granted and we have a local supplier on board with our plans. Our plan would also help in developing the space into a community bookable resource with a large secure enclosed activity field.

Unfortunately, once again, rising costs have left us short of our target by between £10k and £15k so we are hoping that we can make a dent in that gap with donations, whilst continuing to apply for grants and fund raise ourselves!

We are at a critical point in the project as we are ready to place an order for the cabins and the associated groundworks. We have worked so hard and raised so much whilst continuing to provide weekly activities, camps, expeditions, hikes, expeditions, Duke of Edinburgh awards and other activities but we find ourselves with a relatively small gap in funding to fill quite quickly to enable our plan to be fully realised.

So, for the first time ever we are asking for your help via crowdfunding to hopefully allow us to bridge the funding gap as quickly as possible Every little will help.

FEBRUARY – MARCH 2025 WEATHER

February's weather was fairly normal with a mean temperature of 3.5°C and a highest of 13.3°C on the 21st. 3.5°C is actually about half a degree cooler than normal. It was also a dry month with only 65% of normal rainfall. The strongest wind was 43mph, also on the 21st.

In summary the month was relatively dry and slightly cooler than normal. It did actually get guite warm towards the end of the month but in my report last month I wrote that winter can return in March. In fact early March (I am writing this on the 13th) has also been very warm with a record temperature of 16.5°C only a few days ago. This was caused by a large anticyclone to the east of the UK bringing warm winds from the south but we now have a large anticyclone to the west of us bringing winds from the north and the temperature has fallen dramatically to 2.8°. The saying that 'March comes in like a lion but out like a lamb' reflects the swings in temperature that we can expect.

We are all slowly getting used to using Centigrade to measure temperatures. The USA still clings to using the Fahrenheit scale. The Centigrade scale was first proposed by the Swedish scientist Anders Centigrade working at the University of Uppsala. He was interested in gravity and was using a pendulum to measure the strength of gravity. He found that his pendulum was affected by the temperature in his laboratory so he measured the temperature by using a glass thermometer and put a scale on it with 100°C as the freezing point and zero as the boiling point of water. It was only after his death that it was suggested that the scale should be reversed with zero as the freezing point. With others, Celsius did use his measurements to show that gravity changes as you move towards the North Pole and that Isaac Newton was correct in predicting that the Earth is flattened at the poles. Celsius also showed that the Northern Lights are associated with changes in the Earth's magnetic field as measured by small movements in a magnetic compass. Sadly, Celsius died at the age of 42 in 174 from tuberculosis. Brian Brown



Understanding anti-social behaviour (ASB)

We hear the term used often, but do you know what classes as anti-social behaviour? The law defines anti-social behaviour as behaviour that 'causes, or is likely to cause, harassment, alarm or distress to any person'.

What anti-social behaviour is:

Anti-social behaviour covers many types of behaviour, such as:

- Noise nuisance
- Criminal damage, vandalism, graffiti
- Intimidation, threats, harassment · Litter, dog fouling, fly tipping
- · Deliberate fire setting
- Nuisance vehicles
- · Drunken and rowdy behaviour in a public place or drug misuse

· Hate behaviour, targetting people because of their perceived differences. What we take into consideration: How often the behaviour is happening, how serious it is and how it affects the people living in the community.

What anti-social behaviour is not:

A lot of reports to us are not necessarily acts of ASB, such as:

- · The sound of children playing or a baby crying
- · Everyday living noises, such as toilet flushing, closing doors, vacuuming
- · Minor personal disputes and differences
- · Young people gathering socially, unless they are being intimidating
- · Someone being parked outside of your home, where there are no lawful restrictions in place




