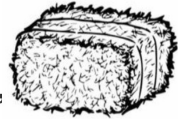

## **DRONFIELD POLICE SAFER NEIGHBOURHOOD TEAM**

March crime figures - Violence against the person - 3 crimes, no further crimes of public concern and these incidents relate to the same reported incident.

Derbyshire Constabulary will be supporting **Operation Sceptre**, a national week of action focused on tackling knife crime, running from Monday 18th to Sunday 24th May.

Operation Sceptre brings together police forces, partners and communities across the country to take action against knife crime and serious violence while also highlighting the work that takes place all year round in Derbyshire to keep our communities safe.



### ***What you can expect to see***

Officers and staff across Derbyshire will be carrying out a range of activity, including:-

- High-visibility patrols and targeted operations
- Knife sweeps in parks and public spaces
- Engagement with schools, colleges and youth groups
- Work with local businesses to promote responsible knife sales
- Knife amnesty locations where unwanted knives can be safely surrendered

### ***Knife amnesty – dispose safely***

If you have an unwanted knife or bladed item, this is an opportunity to **hand it in safely and anonymously**. Removing a knife from circulation could help prevent serious harm or save a life.

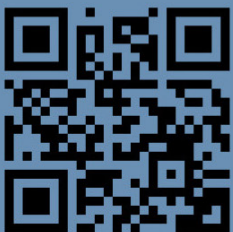

### **MARCH-APRIL 2026 WEATHER**

Here we are in the middle of spring. I am writing this note whilst still a long way away from Holmesfield, within sight of the southern cross in the night sky, so I am using weather information from Bradway where my friend Peter lives. Bradway is a little lower than Holmesfield so it should be slightly warmer there, but the difference will be small.

The mean temperature was 7.4°C which is about one degree warmer than usual. The lowest temperature during March in Bradway was -0.6°C on the 26th, so frost was still around.

Rainfall was 53mm which is 80% of normal. Most of it fell on only three days, the 12th, 24th and 25th. There was even sleet on the 25th and wind speeds of 36mph on the 29th.

There were 16 dry days, so March was a fairly warm but unremarkable month with no record weather readings.

This variability continued into April with storm *Dave* on the 4th and 5th giving high winds, especially in Scotland. This was followed by quite variable weather. I received an email saying that the temperature had reached 22.6°C on 8th April, but the following day it had fallen to 7.9°C.

You will be reading this report in early May, the final month of spring, so the gardens should be springing into life which is a lovely time of the year.

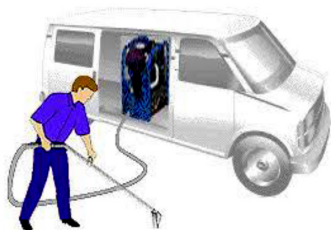

### MILLERS DALE WALK

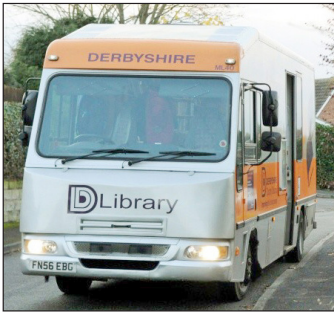

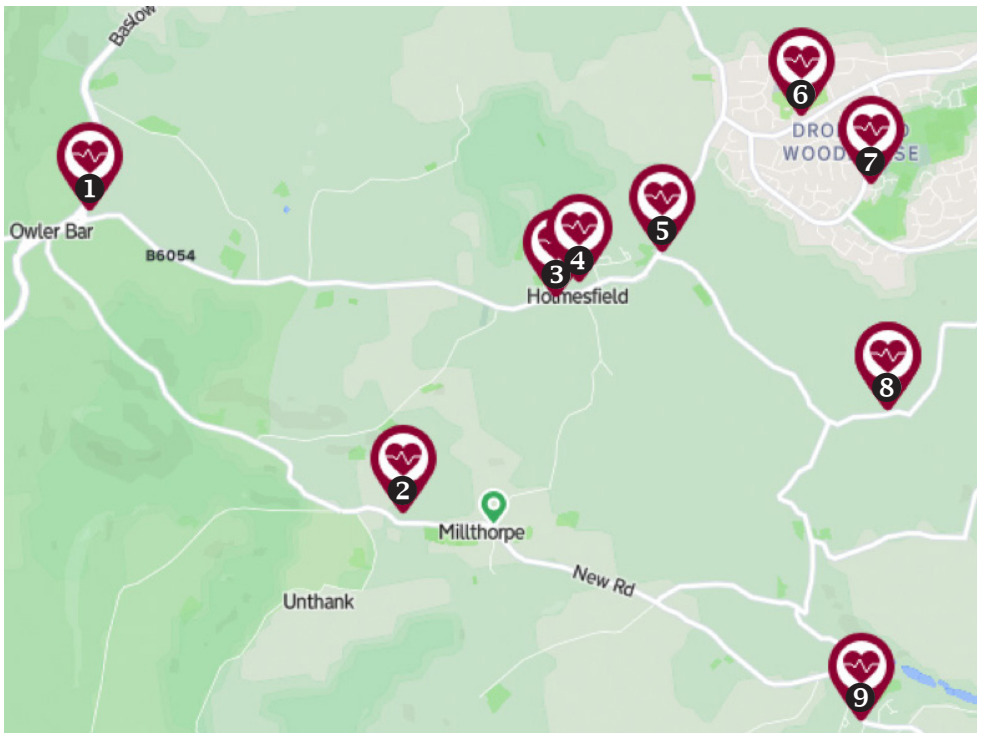

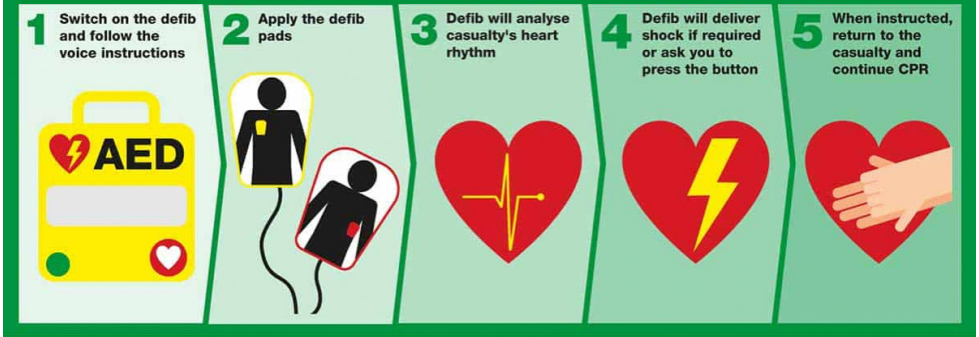

***What can I put in my Food Waste Caddy?***

### ***Yes please:***

Raw and cooked food  
Meat, fish, shellfish (including meat/fish bones)  
Fruit, salad, vegetables, vegetable peelings  
Eggs including egg shells  
Dairy products (No Milk)  
Bread, cakes and other baked goods  
Pasta, rice, beans and pulses  
Tea bags and coffee grounds  
Lard and other hard fats  
Any meal leftovers and plate scrapings  
Pet food  
Mouldy and out of date food

***Food can be placed in compostable food bags manufactured to the British Standard EN 13432 only. (No retail carrier bags). The use of liners is optional, however, we recommend compostable liners to help keep the caddy clean.***

***What can't I put in my Food Waste Caddy?***

### ***No thanks:***

Liquids  
Oils and soft fats  
Packaging (unless specified as compostable)  
Bags (except compostable bags manufactured to the British Standard EN 13432)  
Coffee filters and pods (even those that are compostable)  
Non-food items (including dead animals which do not qualify as food waste).

***Please do not contaminate your food waste container with unsuitable waste. If incorrect items are found in your food waste caddy, it may unfortunately not be emptied. In such cases, you will need to remove the contamination, and the caddy will be collected on your next scheduled collection day.***
