DRONFIELD POLICE SAFER NEIGHBOURHOOD TEAM

Crime Prevention information:

As the nights get darker earlier, the fear of crime can increase. Here are a few things you can do to feel safer:

- Leave a light on in more than one room, such as the lounge and bedroom. Remember to choose low-energy lamps.
- Use a timer switch to operate the lights as it starts to get dark.
- Change the times that the lights come on to create the illusion that someone is moving around inside the home.
- Consider the use of 'smart' technology to have different lights coming on in your house at different times.
- Make sure your front door is well lit and fully visible from the street. Also think about security lighting at the rear and side of your property.
- Consider having a good quality CCTV system installed.
- Keep your curtains closed at night - if you are away, ask a neighbour to close them for you.



Retail Crime Update:

#Sentenced - Two males, Steven HOOTON and Lee GARDNER – both from Low Edges in Sheffield – are the latest of a number of people that have been arrested, interviewed and charged with retail shop theft from local stores in Dronfield including Dronfield Sainsbury's, Co-Op Pentland Road and Co-Op Hartington Road in Dronfield amongst others. These two males who had been identified as prolific shoplifters were remanded by Police and appeared in Court charged for multiple shop lifting offences. One male received a 26 week custodial sentence, the other 4 weeks suspended for 12 months plus a number of Court outcomes.

Dronfield SNT in conjunction with other Derbyshire, Police departments have been working hard with retail stores in Dronfield to improve reporting and recording of theft offences and to identify the most prolific shop lifters coming to the town. This work remains ongoing, and we are keen to inform residents and visitors to the town that we will prosecute and take appropriate action to support local business and retailers appropriately.

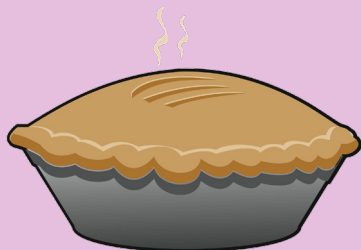

A NEW AND GLORIOUS MORN.

***A thrill of hope the weary world rejoices,
For yonder breaks a new and glorious morn;***

As Christmas approaches once more, I wanted to talk to you about expectations. When it comes to Christmas, the build up, the present shopping, the decorations and the food prep, we do have to be very careful that we don't overload the season (and more importantly one another) with unrealistic expectations. How many Christmases have been ruined, dashed against the rocks of the unrealistic expectations of a "*perfect Christmas*"? It means that Christmas is a particularly inconvenient time to find yourself ill in hospital, being skint, and so forth; or when pressures arise to buy X for Johnny but the Yodel delivery inevitably goes missing, or the pub mistakenly double booked and your table is gone; or (tiny violin at the ready!) the new Goldbergh ski jacket is not going to arrive in time for the St. Moritz trip... all of which raises the inevitable decree, "*That's Christmas ruined*". But bad stuff happens all year round, it only seems worse at Christmas because we (almost certainly wrongly) assume that everybody else is having '*the most wonderful time of the year*'.

Personally, I'd rather risk being disappointed that a more concrete hope has not yet been realised. Christ's first coming to earth circa the year Zero, important as it is, is a mere foreshadowing of what is to come when Christ returns. Advent is actually a season originally devoted to prepare our hearts for Christ's return, much like Lent prepares us to celebrate his resurrection. During Advent, in the midst of all the busyness, do you think you could find the time to pause just for a moment to wait expectantly for Christ? I wager that if you can do this, you may find your expectations of Christmas reduce but your genuine joy and wonder of the season increases.

At your parish church of St. Swithin, we have been patiently waiting for some pretty exciting refurbishment works to begin, but we'll have to wait until the Spring to unwrap that present! Work in the church is however due to commence in January so please note that during this time services will have to be held in the church hall.

Looking back over the year, I find myself feeling really thankful for the villages and hamlets that make up our parish, and especially for the (actually quite small) army of volunteers who work so hard to make Holmesfield a real community. So I will end by giving thanks for them and by encouraging others to offer their time and talents for the benefit of others in 2026.

May you and those you love be blessed with genuine joy and peace this Christmas time.

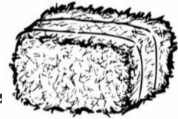

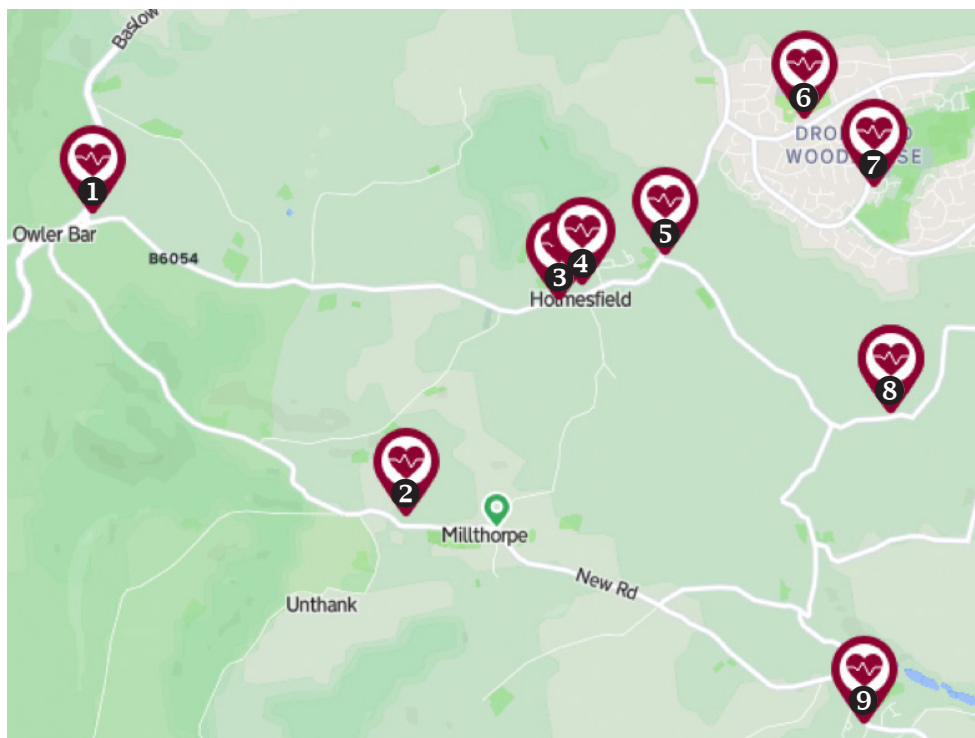

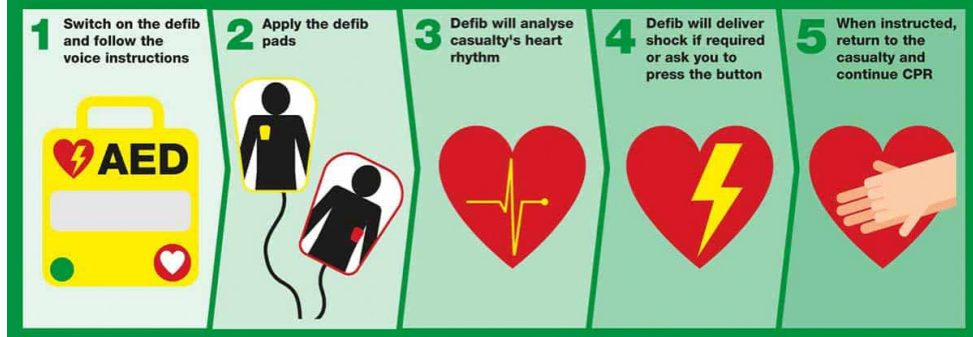

OCTOBER – NOVEMBER 2025 WEATHER

October and early November this year have been typical autumn months. Rainfall was slightly less than normal, temperatures were about normal and we have had some windy spells. On 22nd-23rd October, storm Benjamin affected the southern part of the UK. I recorded a maximum wind speed of only 30mph and we actually had a stronger wind of 44mph on 28th October.

If you remember my previous month's weather report, you may have been surprised that the name Benjamin was used because I had stated that the next storm would be called Bram. The reason for this is that the UK Met Office did not think that the storm warranted a name, however the French decided that as it was to be more severe in France, they gave it the name Benjamin.

October did contain many cloudy days but I did record 135 hours of bright sunshine, which is about what can be expected in autumn. In the summer, I usually record about 370 hours each month.

The hours of bright sunshine used to be recorded with an instrument called a *Campbell-Stokes Sunshine Recorder*. This consisted of a glass sphere that focused the sun onto a card and so burnt the card when the sun was sufficiently bright. The card was placed on a curved surface behind the glass sphere so as the sun moved round it traced a burnt line whose length could be calibrated in hours. Campbell was the inventor who built the first recorder in 1853. Stokes was a professor of mathematics at Cambridge University and he improved and calibrated the recorder a few years later. Stokes was actually Sir George Gabriel Stokes and he held the Lucasian Chair in Mathematics at Cambridge University. This is said to be the most prestigious Chair of Mathematics in the World and holders have included Sir Isaac Newton and Professor Stephen Hawking. The Campbell-Stokes Sunshine Recorder has now been superseded by electronic recorders that use a photocell. They measure the number of kilowatts (kW) of heat provided by the sun over one square metre. The maximum that can be recorded in the middle of summer is about 1.2 kW, a bit like what you can feel in front of a one bar electric fire. It was decided that bright sunshine had to be at least 10% of this, so if the recording is higher than 0.12 kW it is recorded as bright sunshine. By the time we get to December the sun never rises very high in the sky so there are not many hours when the sunshine recorded is greater than 0.12 kW.

I am writing this report on 13th November and so far this month we have had 24 hours of bright sunshine which is about two hours each day. There is still a little warmth in the sun and it can certainly cause dazzle when driving into the sun.

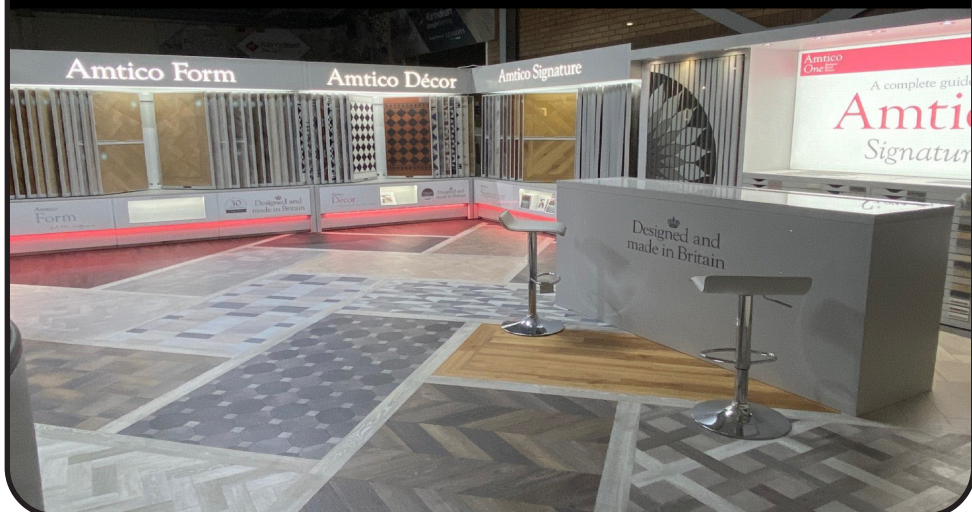

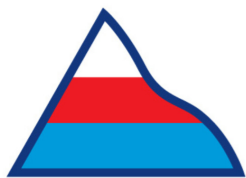

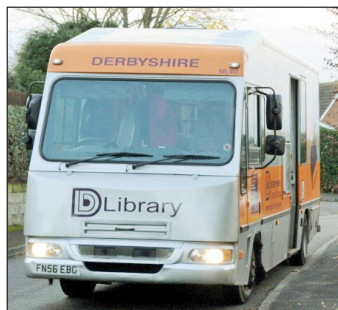

WINTER FUEL SCAM WARNING

If you receive a text message about winter fuel payments, it's a scam.

Don't click on any links!

Derbyshire Trading Standards is warning about winter fuel payment scam text messages that are doing the rounds.

Winter fuel payments will happen automatically. You don't need to make a claim.

Between April and September 2025, Action Fraud received 2,790 crime reports relating to Winter Fuel Payment scams with victims reporting losses totalling over £27,000.

Not sure if a message is real? Contact the organisation directly using the contact details on their official website, not the number or web address in the message. Your bank (or any other official source) won't ask you to supply personal information by email or text message.

If you have spotted a suspicious SMS or RCS message, you can report it for FREE by forwarding it to 7726.

If you think you've been a victim of fraud, contact your bank immediately and report it to Action Fraud online at actionfraud.police.uk or by calling 0300 123 2040

UNDERSTANDING ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR (ASB)

We hear the term ASB often, but do you know what is classed as anti-social behaviour?

Often reports may not be necessary or they're reported to the wrong agency. Find out the correct reporting method and how we can support you on Derbyshire's ASB Hub: www.saferderbyshire.gov.uk/asbhub



Understanding anti-social behaviour (ASB)

We hear the term used often, but do you know what classes as anti-social behaviour?

The law defines anti-social behaviour as behaviour that 'causes, or is likely to cause, harassment, alarm or distress to any person'.

What anti-social behaviour is:

Anti-social behaviour covers many types of behaviour, such as:

- Noise nuisance
- Criminal damage, vandalism, graffiti
- Intimidation, threats, harassment
- Litter, dog fouling, fly tipping
- Deliberate fire setting
- Nuisance vehicles
- Drunken and rowdy behaviour in a public place or drug misuse
- Hate behaviour, targetting people because of their perceived differences.

What we take into consideration: How often the behaviour is happening, how serious it is and how it affects the people living in the community.

What anti-social behaviour is not:

A lot of reports to us are not necessarily acts of ASB, such as:

- The sound of children playing or a baby crying
- Everyday living noises, such as toilet flushing, closing doors, vacuuming
- Minor personal disputes and differences
- Young people gathering socially, unless they are being intimidating
- Someone being parked outside of your home, where there are no lawful restrictions in place
- DIY and car repairs unless they are taking place at unsocial hours
- Civil disputes between neighbours (e.g. shared driveways)
- Religious or cultural practice.

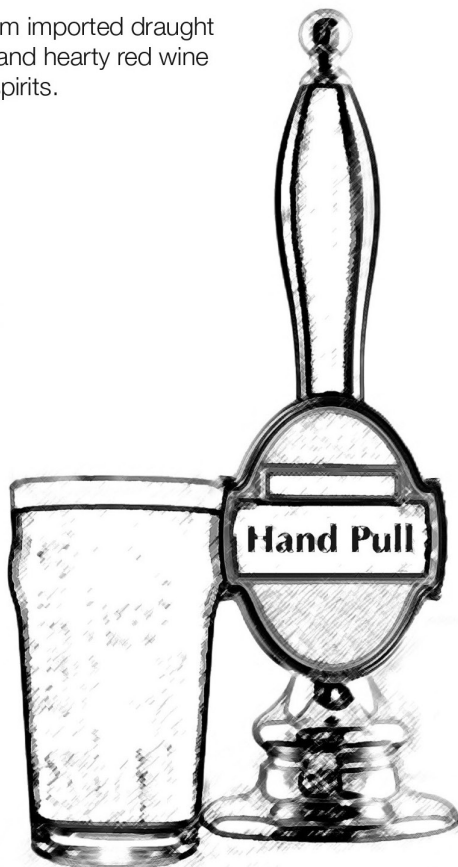

HOLMESFIELD BYGONES



The popularity of Cordwell Valley with walkers and day trippers saw it have at least two popular cafes. With the closure of Cordwell Café, latterly run by the Chettleburgh family, it left just Millthorpe cafe to serve visitor refreshments.

Thanks to Cedric Morris for sharing the above view of him with Peter Helliwell and Rodney Clarke in the early 1950s outside Millthorpe Café. There was a timber shelter with outdoor seating to the right of the cafe but this blew down in the gales of 1963 as seen in the below photo taken by Julian Haslam's dad. Also visible is the car owned by the proprietor, Mr McFarlane.

The replacement "Bobbies Cafe" was built in the 1970s and is fondly remembered.
