Applications Received from North East Derbyshire District Council:

25/00128/FL : Mr. & Mrs. Machen – Cordwell Barn, Horsleygate Lane, Holmesfield - Demolition of existing barn and erection of a single storey dwelling with attached garage and amenity areas, and a private drainage system (Conservation Area) (setting of a listed building) (amended plans).

COMMENT: Concern that this application following amendment is still to demolish rather than convert an existing barn. It is considered that if the barn is to be converted that it should be done on the original footprint rather than the building of a new property. It is considered that the proposal would not be in keeping with the rural location in the greenbelt, Conservation Area and within the setting of a listed building.

25/00938/FLH : Mr. T. Martin – 47 Main Road, Holmesfield – Demolition of a single storey rear extension and the rebuild of a larger single storey rear extension. **NO COMMENT**

25/00998/FLH : Ms. N. Formela – Rose Cottage, Unthank Lane, Holmesfield – Single storey side extension (Conservation Area) (Affecting Public Right of Way).

COMMENT: Concern as to why the extension is being proposed on the adjacent green belt field rather than within the domestic curtilage.

DRONFIELD POLICE SAFER NEIGHBOURHOOD TEAM

Crime Prevention information:

A Happy New Year to all those who reside and work in Dronfield and surrounding rural villages and settlements.

Current team priorities linked to data and community feedback:

1. Road safety concerns including speeding vehicles and irresponsible parking.
2. ASB – Fly tipping in rural areas.
3. ASB – Youth related in woodland areas such as next to Sindlefingen Park and Kitchen Wood.
4. Vehicle crime and burglary concerns including crime prevention advice/awareness.



Derbyshire Constabulary have been working with *BikeRegister*, the national cycle database for some time to offer bike security.

Bike marking is important as it primarily acts as a visible deterrent to would-be thieves and it makes it easier for the bike to be found and returned to its rightful owner whilst helping to secure a successful prosecution against thieves. This is something to consider as you may have children who receive a new bike for Christmas or birthdays.

Derbyshire Community Speedwatch Scheme

A scheme that enables groups of trained community volunteers to directly contribute to reducing the problem of speeding vehicles on local roads. Speeding is a source of concern for several communities, not only in terms of its potential to kill and seriously injure others, but also the anti-social levels of noise and increased pollution it creates.

By working in partnership, the police and local communities can, in identifying and dealing with speeding motorists, make a real contribution towards reducing the incidence of speeding, improving the quality of life for all.

NEW RAILWAY TIMETABLE UPDATES

A new timetable for trains from Dronfield commenced on 14th December. The revised timetable is provided on page 49 courtesy of Friends of Dronfield Station. There have been no major changes, just the odd few minutes difference here and there.

Meanwhile, on the Sheffield to Manchester route at Dore and Totley, after all the millions spent on the revamped station, Hope Valley tracks and signalling, it was hoped that there would be more stopping trains, but the station has actually lost 1 in 3 of Northern Rail's Sunday stopping trains! The previously hourly service having been replaced by two trains every three hours.

However, Dore and Totley will be getting a new stop from Sheffield at 08:15 to Stockport, Manchester Piccadilly and Liverpool operated by Trans-Pennine Express.

A new East Midlands Railway service from Nottingham stops at Dore and Totley at 09:48 for Stockport and Manchester which returns as a new service from Manchester at 11:41 calling at Dore and Totley at 12.26 for Sheffield, Nottingham and stations to Norwich.







REPORTING HGVs FLOUTING WEIGHT LIMITS

The Parish Council understands that there are two ways to report HGVs flouting weight limits in the parish.

The first is via *Trading Standards* at Derbyshire County Council. They have an online weight restriction monitoring form if you'd like to report any vehicles you believe are illegally using restricted roads. You'll need to provide details such as date and time of incident, registration number and location. If you have a photograph of the vehicle, it can be attached to the form.

They will collate the information and share it with Derbyshire police to inform and prioritise police-led enforcement action. Unlike the police, they have very limited powers to deal with vehicles that breach weight restrictions and will not be able to respond to individual reports. However, the information is important to help identify problem areas.

Alternatively, you can report incidents directly to the police, telephone: 101 and pass on the details or by following the link

We understand that the police now require video evidence to be able to take the matter further.





NOVEMBER – DECEMBER 2025 WEATHER

This November was remarkable for being very wet. I recorded 203mm (eight inches), which is more than double the rainfall we can usually expect. I have only recorded one wetter November and that was in 2019 when I recorded 234mm. That remains the wettest of any month that I have recorded since 2002.

The wettest day during November this year was the 14th, when about three inches of rain fell during the day and a further inch overnight. This rainfall was sufficient to flood the road at East Hollow below the Rutland Arms and leave one car stranded.

There are several other days in my records that were about as wet as 14th November this year and these were in 2018, 2019, 2023 and 2024. It is interesting that all five of these very wet days were during the autumn and occurred during the last seven years. Between 2002 and 2017 there were no such very wet days. Is the weather getting wetter?

In terms of temperature, November was almost completely normal. The warmest day was the 4th at 15.8°C and the coldest the 20th at -2.8°C. We enjoyed 65 hours of sunshine, but as I discussed last month, we cannot expect much bright sunshine as we enter the winter months. You will remember that the spring and summer this year were very dry, and many parts of the country had hosepipe bans imposed. However, the autumn months have almost made up for the dry months and the year as a whole will be almost normal.

I have looked at the total rainfall I have recorded for each year since 2002. The five wettest years were 2012, 2019, 2020, 2023 and 2024. It would appear that we are having a run of wet years. Is this a consequence of global warming? Who knows.

I am writing this note on 8th December and so far the weather has not been exceptional in any way. At the moment, the estimated chance of a 'white Christmas' in our area is 20-25%. Sheffield normally sees 1-2 days with some snow during December. By the time you read this, you will know if this year was one of those 1-2 days. *Brian Brown*







Travel Derbyshire on Demand

Travel Derbyshire on Demand is a new type of bus service. It must be booked in advance but is more flexible than a conventional bus. There is no fixed timetable, so pick up times, routes and destinations can be planned to suit the needs of where and when passengers want to travel. It is fully accessible and able to carry passengers in wheelchairs and has space for pushchairs. **Travel Derbyshire on Demand** is for everyone, young or old, and can be used for any type of journey. So if you want to visit friends, need to get to a medical appointment, the shops or work, then **Travel Derbyshire on Demand** is for you.

What journeys can I make on the service?

You can travel anywhere within the operating area, which covers the Districts of Bolsover and North East Derbyshire and the Borough of Chesterfield. You can also travel from within the operating area to and from Kings Mill Hospital in Sutton in Ashfield, or Alfreton train station.

How do I sign up?

Call **0115 969 1801** or use the **Travel Derbyshire on Demand** app, which can be downloaded via your usual app store. Register with your name, mobile phone number and email address.

When you first sign in, you will be asked for more information to enable your journey to be scheduled and to monitor use of the service.

How do I book a journey?

Call **0115 969 1801** or use the **Travel Derbyshire on Demand** app. Specify your preferred pick up or drop off time and we will try to meet your request or offer another time. If you have an appointment to meet, book your preferred drop off time. Allow plenty of time before your appointment to make sure you don't arrive late. Note that you may be on the bus for up to 75 minutes.

When does the service operate?

- Monday to Friday 7am to 7pm
- Saturdays 8am to 5pm
- No service on Sundays or Public Holidays, excluding Good Friday

Frequently Asked Questions

How far in advance do I need to book?

Book up to 28 days before you wish to travel. Advance bookings will be prioritised. You can book up to 1-hour before you wish to travel but short-notice bookings cannot be guaranteed.

Can I book for other people?

Yes. All passengers need to register to use the service. You can book for yourself on the app or via the call centre. For all other bookings, including couples, families or groups, contact the call centre. There is space for a wheelchair on the bus.






